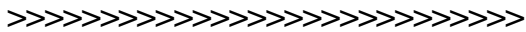
We encourage all members and friends of this association to pay dues each year so that you will have access to the newsletter either through the website or by US mail.

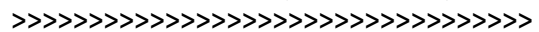
